Why is Recycling CFLs Important?

- **Recycling prevents the release of mercury into the environment.** CFLs and other fluorescent bulbs often break when thrown into a dumpster, trash can or compactor, or when they end up in a landfill or incinerator.
- **Other materials in the bulbs get reused.** Recycling CFLs and other fluorescent bulbs allows for the reuse of the glass, metals, and other materials that make up fluorescent lights. Virtually all components of a fluorescent bulb can be recycled.



Why recycle batteries?

Batteries, in particular those containing silver, cadmium, lead, or acids, have the potential to be hazardous waste.
